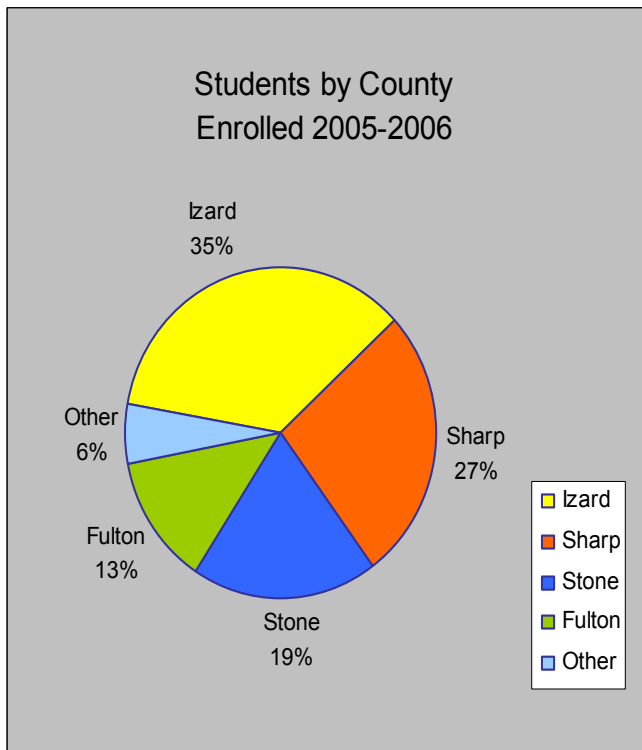

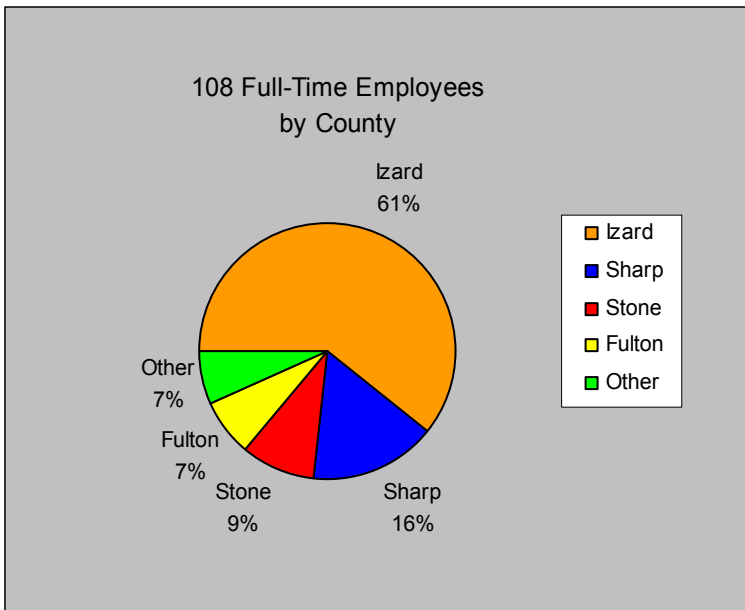

- Total area: 2,420.11 square miles.
