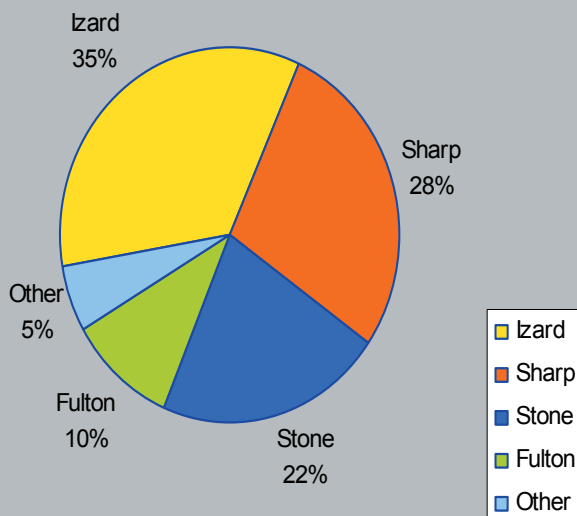

Enrolled Fall 2007**



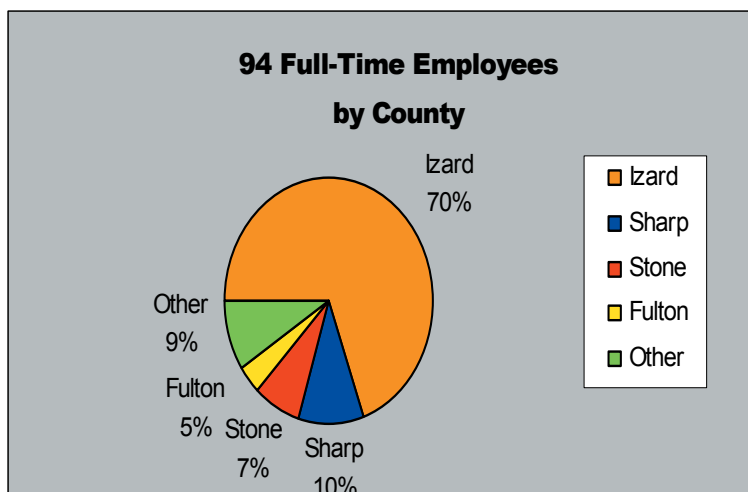

### OZARKA STATISTICS

- Ozarka College service area includes four counties, Fulton, Izard, Sharp, and Stone
  - Estimated population: 54,500.
  - Total area: 2,420.11 square miles.
- Average income per capita in service area: \$17,825.
  - State of Arkansas average: \$22,750
  - National average: \$30,413
- Population below poverty level: 18%-20%, depending on county
  - State of Arkansas average: 16%
  - National Average: 12.7%
- 10.6% of service area population has a Bachelor's degree or higher.
  - State of Arkansas average: 16.7%
  - National average: 24.4%
- Ozarka has a 15:1 student to faculty ratio.
- Ozarka students average age: 30 years old
